
Greetings From Our Pastor

Prayer Meeting

Every Thursday evening at 6:30pm we come together to focus on God, thank Him for His provision and trust Him with the needs of the church and community.

Youth and Children Ministries

Youth and children ministries meet during the school year on Wednesday evenings from 6 – 8 pm.

Senior High youth group meets at the youth rooms in the basement of the parsonage. Meetings include fellowship, snacks, singing, Bible study, and small group discussion. Several additional activities are planned throughout the year.

Junior High youth group meets at the youth rooms in the basement of the parsonage. Their meetings include fellowship, games, snacks, lessons, and the Bible Instruction Class (BIC). BIC covers Bible survey, Bible doctrines, and practical Christian living.

Sonshine Club is for children from Kindergarten through 6th grade. Children participate in games and learn Bible verses and Bible lessons in a fun and exciting atmosphere designed just for them.
